## 多元化學習活動



### 臨床見習及實習

臨床學習是中醫教學的重要部份,學生在帶教老師指導下學習診治知識及技能。見習主要安排在香港中醫診所進行,而實習地點則主要為廣州及深圳的三甲中醫院。



### 學院背景

香港中文大學中醫學院成立於1998年,為本港三所提供中醫課程的大專院校之一。本學院開辦各類中醫藥專業課程,致力培育新一代中醫師,以回應社會對註冊中醫師的需求。同時,中醫學院為在職中醫師提供持續進修專業課程,提升醫師的專業水平;並積極向公眾推廣中醫普及教育,多年來廣受各界讚賞。

中醫學院非常重視中醫畢業生的持續教育,近年致力於本港多個地區開拓臨床培訓基地,為即將成立的中醫院儲備足夠的中醫專科人才。本學院更已禮任多位國醫大師為本院顧問,並與內地多個學術流派建立傳承工作站,以達薪火相傳,學術傳承的目的。

### 課程結構

主修課程要求

本課程包括兩個部分: (甲) 臨牀前期課程(四年半)及(乙) 臨牀實習課程(一年半)

### 臨牀前期課程

臨牀前期課程為期四年半。學生須修畢中醫基礎知識、 基礎醫學及生命科學、中醫經典及學術流派、中醫臨牀 學科、中醫學研究方法等必修及選修科目。此外,學生 或須於暑假進行見習。

### 臨牀實習課程

臨牀實習課程為期一年半。學生須在內地中醫院進行 全科臨牀實習,包括內科、外科、婦科、兒科、骨傷 科及針灸科等。完成全科實習後,學生將在內地或本 地進行專科實習。

學生須修畢主修科目最少157學分及大學核心課程所需之39學分,以符合畢業資格。完成全部課程及考試及格者, 將獲頒授中醫學學士學位。本課程畢業生可申請報考由香港中醫藥管理委員會舉辦的香港中醫執業資格試,通過考 試後可成為香港註冊中醫師。

第六學年	臨牀實習

以及中醫選修科目(2至6學分)、醫學院課程(10學分)及大學核心科目(39學分)

# **Programme Characteristics**

### **Emphasis on Classical Knowledge in Chinese Medicine**

Chinese medicine is a medical system comprising unique philosophies in the nature and human body. With our strong emphasis on the classical Chinese medicine knowledge, students will develop deep insight in traditional Chinese culture and master clinical reasoning skills in TCM. In the meantime, by equipping students with knowledge in modern medicine and research skills, students are expected not only to inherit the classical theories and traditional mode of thought in Chinese medicine, but also to make innovations in the modern world.

### **Integration of Theory into Practice**

To enhance the integration of theoretical knowledge in Chinese Medicine and clinical skills, the School introduces clinical training throughout the six-year curriculum. Students are required to start clinical attachments as early as the first year of the study, and end with one and a half year of continuous internship at affiliated clinics in Hong Kong and hospitals in China. During the study period, different learning objectives and clinical training tasks have been designed in catering for students' learning ability at different stages. Students are expected to gradually develop a good understanding in principles of different TCM diagnosis and treatment methods, and get familiar with handling common clinical cases, emergency cases and cases of different specialties. They will gain a strong foundation for their future career development after completion of the programme.

### Well-developed Network to Broaden Students' Vision

The School has established a collaboration network with local, Mainland China and overseas partners, by which benefit our students in many aspects. As a key member in Faculty of Medicine, our students are fully supported in pre-clinical training by the Faculty, and students will experience quality and inspiring education through meeting and sharing with professionals from different health care sectors. Apart from the self-established teaching clinics, the School also works closely with Chinese medicine clinics and teaching hospitals in local and Mainland China to provide various clinical practice and employment opportunities for students.

# **Programme Structure**

The Programme consists of two parts: the Pre-clinical Programme and the Clinical Programme

### Pre-clinical Programme (4.5 years)

The pre-clinical programme extends over four and a half academic years. Students are required to complete courses including subjects in basic medical and life sciences, Chinese medical concepts and theories, Chinese medicine classics, various specialties in Chinese medicine, and Chinese medicine research methodologies.

### Clinical Programme (1.5 years)

The last one and a half years of the study are devoted to clinical training in a hospital setting. Students will spend time at Chinese medicine hospitals affiliated with Guangzhou University of Chinese Medicine for conducting clinical practice in various specialties. In addition to the training in hospitals, students may also conduct practicum at out-patient clinics of Chinese medicine in Hong Kong for a certain period of time in order to gain practical experience as general practitioners.

# **Professional Recognition**

The programme is an undergraduate programme of Chinese medicine training, which is recognized by the Hong Kong Chinese Medicine Council. Graduates are qualified to sit for the Chinese Medicine Practitioners Licensing Examination conducted by the Council. Those who pass the examination are eligible to become Registered Chinese Medicine Practitioners (RCMPs) in Hong Kong.
